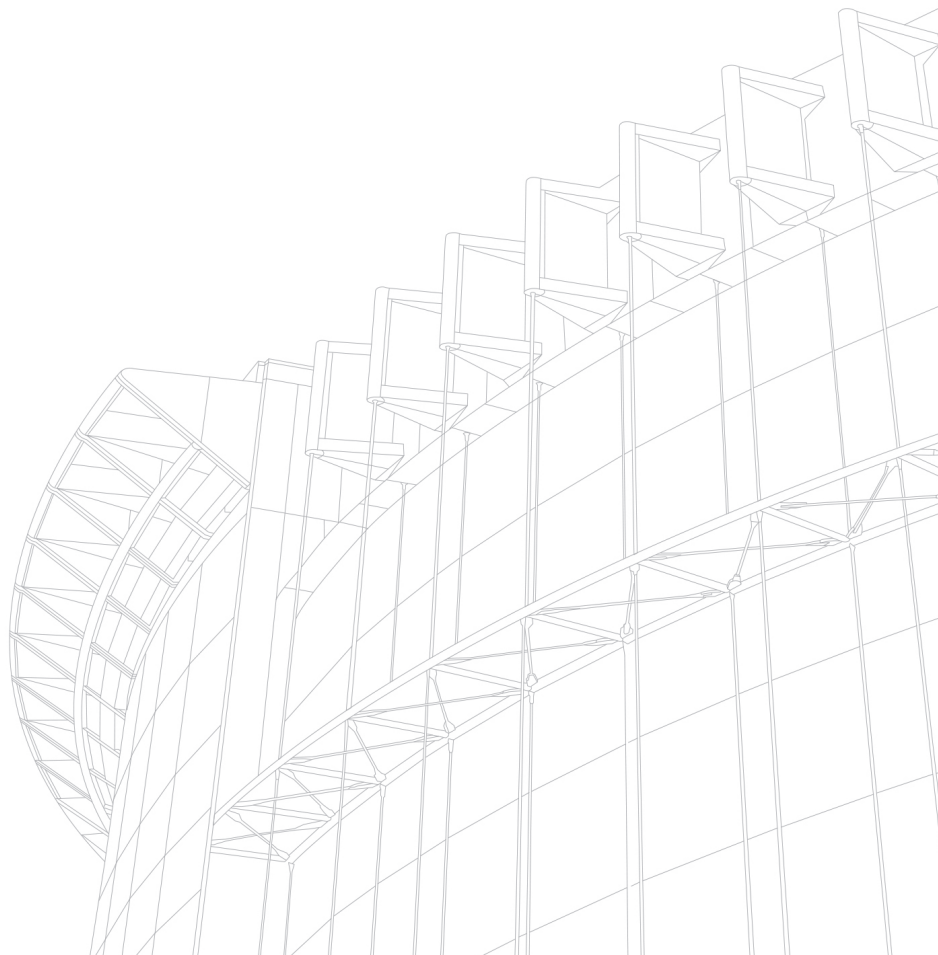

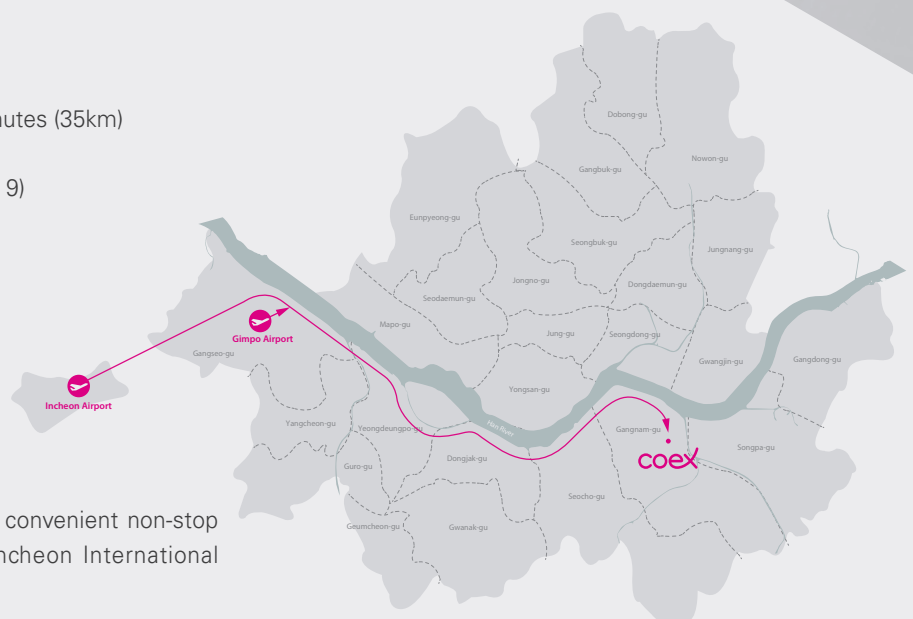

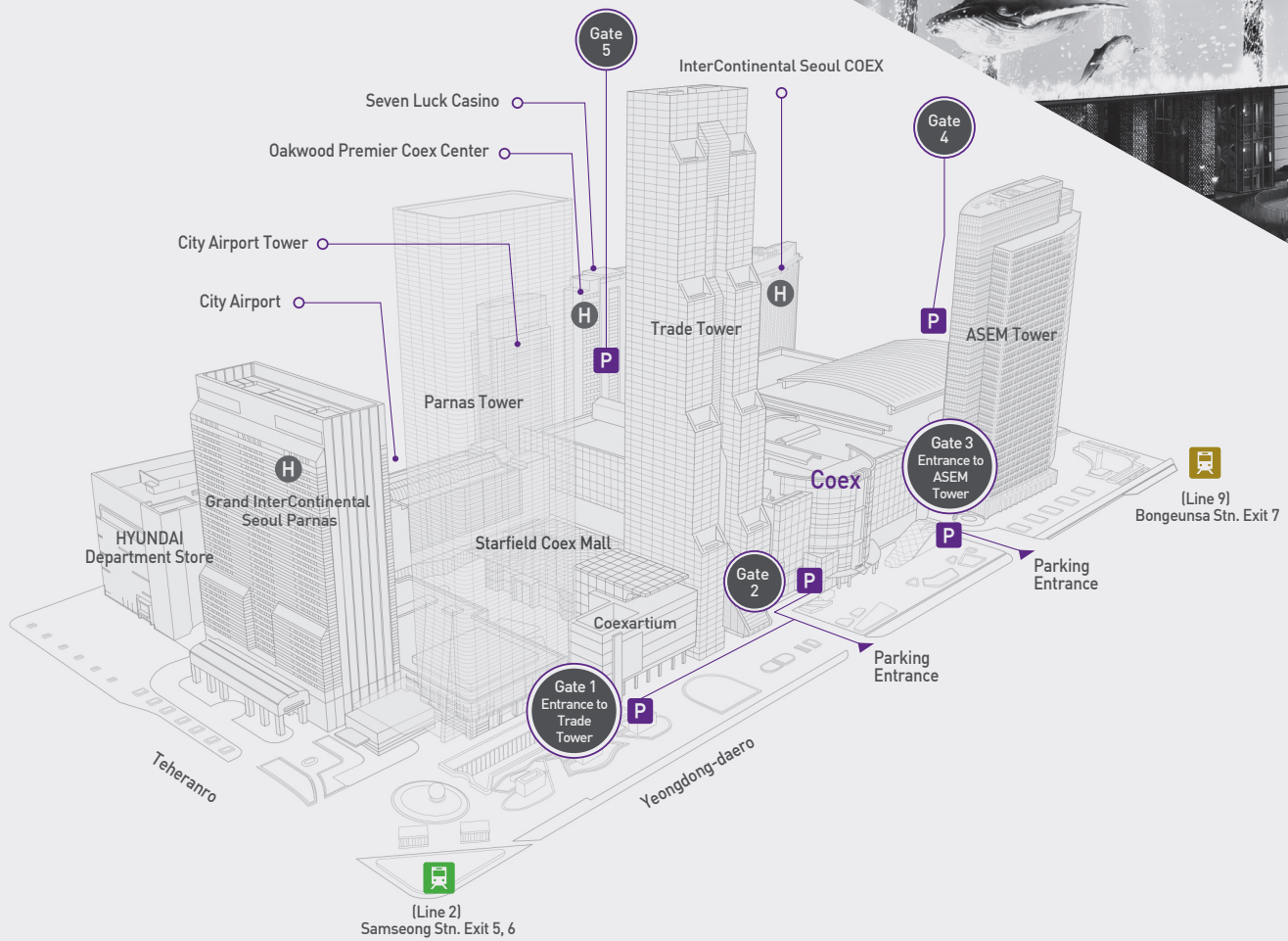
Coex MICE Cluster & Facilities

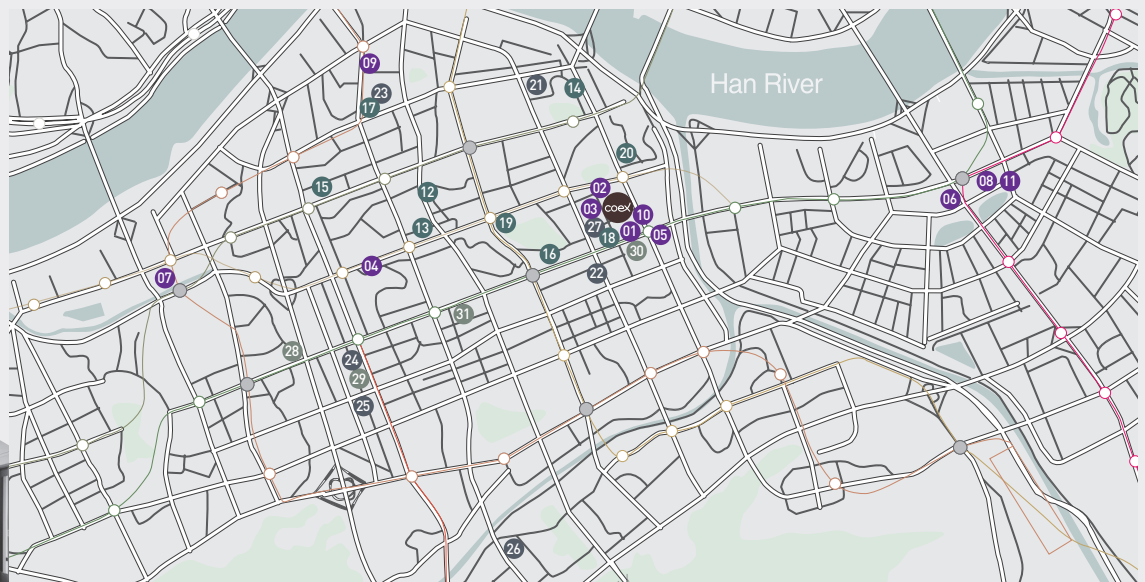

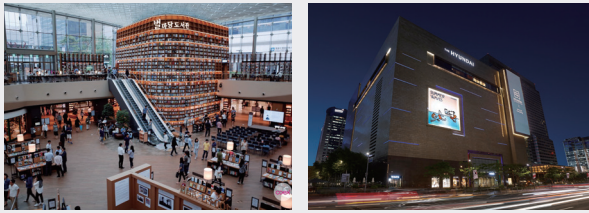


Shopping & Entertainment

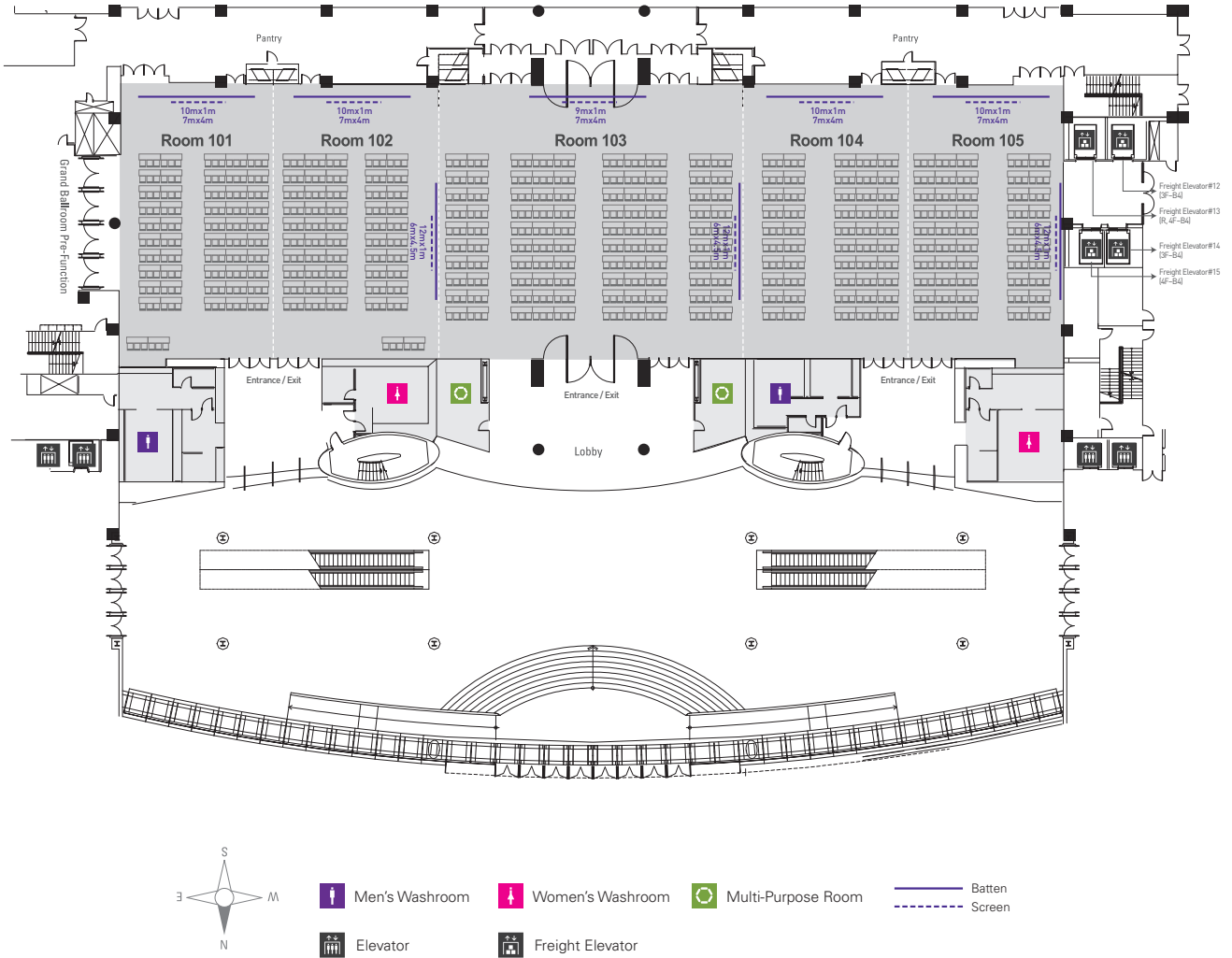
Located on the first floor, the Grand Ballroom is a popular venue and ideal for exhibitions, conferences, corporate dinners, plenary sessions and other special events. Featuring 1,817m² of column-free space, which can be divided into sections with floor-to-ceiling partition walls, the Grand Ballroom is capable of holding five fully separated, self-sufficient, concurrent events simultaneously and can be tailored for all types of events. The multi-purpose rooms located near the main entrance are used as an organizer's office or VIP rooms, and major facilities include a control room, interpreter booths, retractable ceiling screens, a state-of-the-art A/V and lighting system to accommodate all types of events. Another advantage of the Grand Ballroom is its close proximity to the luxurious 5-star hotel, InterContinental Seoul COEX, allowing easy and convenient access for international visitors.

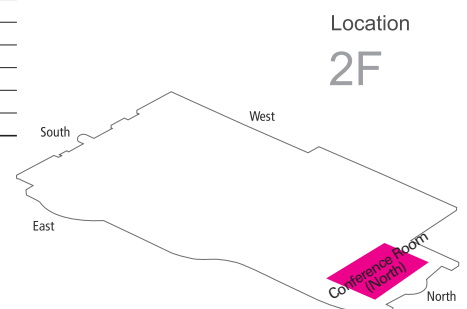


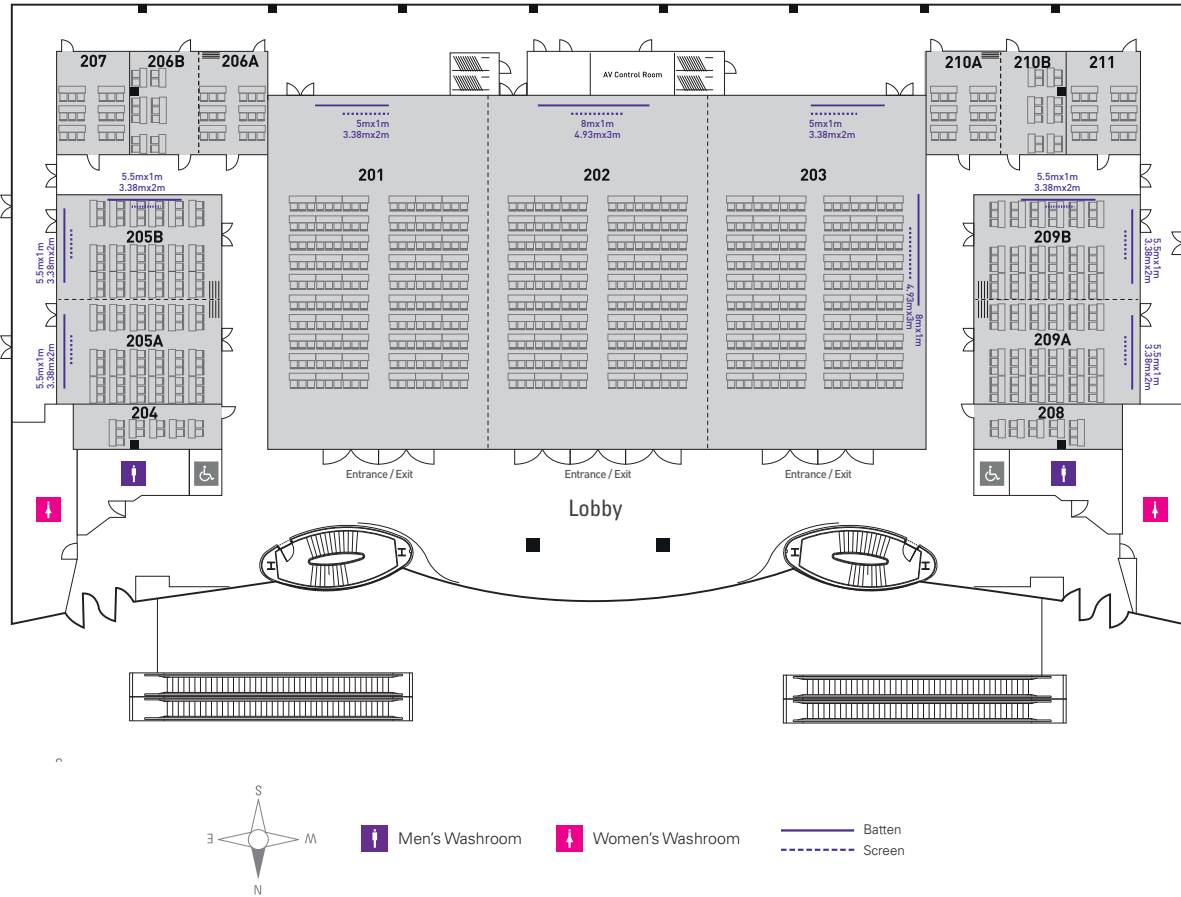


ASEM BALLROOM / CONFERENCE ROOM (NORTH)

Located on the second floor, the Conference Room North features a symmetrical floor plan with the ASEM Ballroom as the focal axis point. The ASEM Ballroom (Rooms 201, 202 & 203 combined) was given its name in 2018 during the renovation to commemorate the 3rd ASEM Summit that took place at this very spot in 2000. Offering up to a 900 capacity in a theater-style seating plan, the ASEM Ballroom is suitable to host large-scale events, especially when used in accompaniment with the Grand Ballroom on the first floor. The eight small to medium-sized rooms (Rooms 204~211) can be used to host individual seminars and workshops and/or as an auxiliary space such as organizer's offices and speaker waiting rooms.

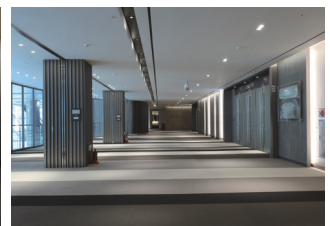

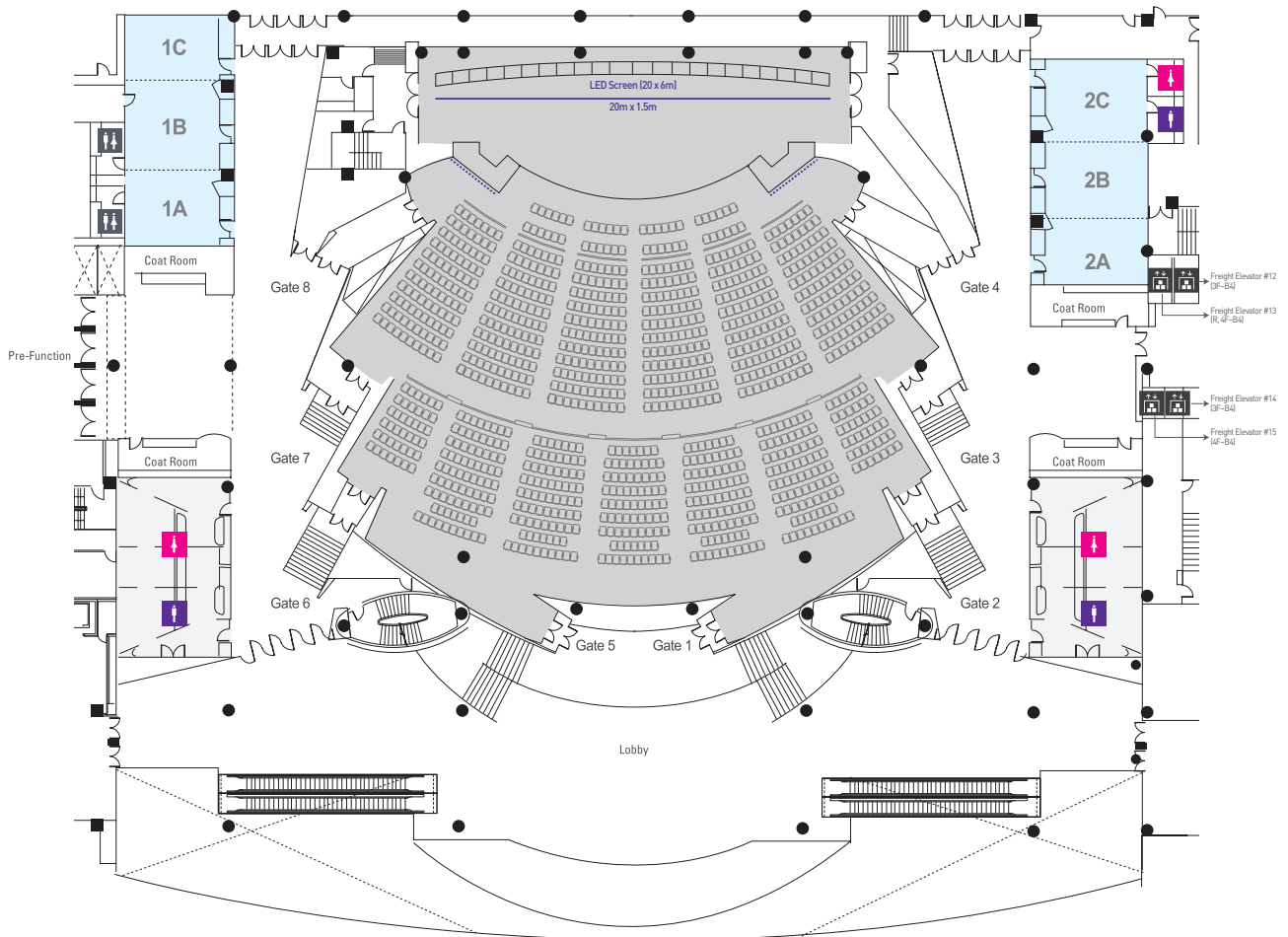
The Auditorium is located on the third floor and seats 1,080 visitors. Its luxurious and striking atmosphere never fails to impress. It is furnished with state-of-the-art equipment, including LED Screen and provides excellent acoustics and visibility. The theater-style room is a popular venue for film previews, award ceremonies, musicals, concerts, and opening ceremonies. Each seat comes with a fold-away tray and an earphone jack that is directly connected to the built-in audio system with twelve translation booths. In addition, four rooms on the third and fourth floor of the Auditorium can be utilized for various purposes such as VIP rooms or press rooms. The Auditorium's 990m² lobby can be used for receptions, registration areas, or for auxiliary exhibitions. The eight entrances around the Auditorium allow for easy access during busy periods, and automated double swing doors make it easier to control large crowds during concerts or seminars.
